## **School Uniform Policy**

We ask all our children to wear school uniform. The school colours are scarlet and navy blue. Sweatshirts, polo-shirts and T-shirts, bearing our school logo, can be obtained from the website: [www.yourschooluniform.com](http://www.yourschooluniform.com).

It is acceptable for children to wear non monogrammed (plain) uniform, eg plain navy blue polo shirt.

### **ALL UNIFORM MUST BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME**

<b>Winter</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Grey skirt or pinafore dress or trousers.</li> <li>• Red or navy blue monogrammed Compton polo shirt.*</li> <li>• Red or navy blue monogrammed Compton sweatshirt or cardigan.*</li> <li>• Plain navy blue, black, red or grey tights.</li> <li>• Plain navy blue, black, white or grey socks.</li> </ul>
<b>Summer</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Red or blue striped or checked dress.</li> <li>• Short grey trousers.</li> <li>• Red or navy blue monogrammed Compton polo shirt.*</li> <li>• Plain navy blue, black, white or grey socks.</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shoes should be sensible – buckled, laced or Velcro-fastened, and black, navy blue or red.</li> <li>• Trainer-type shoes are only acceptable in black.</li> <li>• White trainers are only acceptable for PE/games.</li> <li>• Summer shoes/sandals should be sturdy, safe, and suitable for playtime activities.</li> </ul>
<b>Games/PE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Red or navy blue shorts.</li> <li>• Navy blue tracksuit bottoms.</li> <li>• Red or navy blue T-shirt.</li> <li>• Black or white plimsolls or white trainers.</li> <li>• The above items should be kept in a <b>NAMED</b> PE drawstring bag.</li> </ul>
<b>Other</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children should not wear any jewellery such as rings or necklaces for health and safety reasons.</li> <li>• If a child has their ear pierced, they may wear a stud earring only, which should be covered with tape for PE.</li> <li>• Long hair (below shoulder length) should be tied back.</li> <li>• Hair accessories (hair bands, bows, ribbons, and hair clips etc.) should be kept small and, if possible, in school colours (red or navy).</li> <li>• Hair should be a natural colour.</li> <li>• Hair varnish or any make up is not permitted.</li> </ul>
<b>Outdoor Education</b>	<p>If the children have any planned Forest School activities, parents are informed when these sessions will take place and must ensure that appropriate clothing for wet and muddy conditions is brought in – ie:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Wellies/walking boots and thick socks.</li> <li>• Waterproof jacket/kagoul.</li> <li>• Old jeans and sweatshirt or overalls – leggings are <b>NOT</b> appropriate as they are too thin.</li> <li>• Waterproof trousers.</li> </ul>

*The school welcomes children from all backgrounds and faith communities. If there are serious reasons, for example on religious grounds, why parents want their child to wear clothes that differ from the school uniform (class and PE), the Uniform Policy will consider such requests sympathetically. If any parent would like to request an exception to the uniform policy they should, in the first instance, contact the headteacher and then the Governors.*
