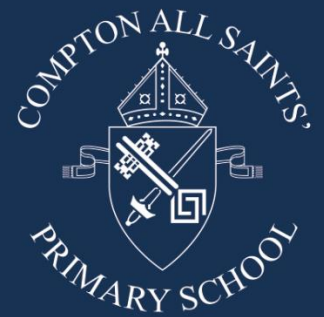


# Compton All Saints' C of E Primary School
